- 3. Receive a budget from the VA based on your care assessment
- 4. With the helpful guidance of Bay Aging's Options Counselors and FMS team, use your care budget to hire and supervise workers, including family or friends, to assist with your care
- 5. If needed, purchase approved items or services needed to live independently in the community
