What is Veteran Directed Care (VDC)?

VDC is a program offered by Bay Aging that helps Veterans with disabilities or chronic conditions live independently at home.

VDC may be the right program for you if...

- 1 You are a Veteran of any age
- 2 You are enrolled in VA health care, or will be soon
- 3 You want to live in your own home
- 4 You're interested in directing your own services



How it works:

Schedule an appointment at a participating Veterans Affairs Medical Center (VAMC)



Receive a budget from the VA based on your care assessment



Work with Bay Aging to complete the enrollment forms



With the guidance of Bay Aging's Options Counselors and FMS team, use your care budget to hire workers and customize your care



If needed, purchase approved items or services to live in your home and community



Achieve goals meaningful to you and your loved ones



VDC gives you **choice and control**

Bay Aging is approved by the VA to offer VDC. We have highly qualified counselors who work with Veterans and their caregivers to develop a personalized program of care.

Bay Aging also has a nationally recognized Financial Management Services (FMS) team available to assist you with electronic timesheets, Participant Dashboard, and payroll and tax-related questions.
